The impact of your patients losing coverage due to increased insurance premiums could send the already vulnerable system into a tailspin. It's time to tell Congress to find common ground and protect access to healthcare for all of our patients.

The ACP Services PAC is taking action and providing internal medicine physicians with a platform to engage directly with members of Congress on important issues such as: **protecting access to vaccines, reinstating telehealth coverage policies with retroactive reimbursement, protecting physician payment, and preserving our public health infrastructure/funding.**
