With the 2024 Election upon us in a few short months, we urgently need your help to keep Internal Medicine on the congressional agenda. ACP Services PAC continues to work with our legislative staff to advance our advocacy initiatives.

More than **100,000 members** are eligible members to contribute to our PAC. With that many IM physicians unified with one voice, we can protect our profession and our patients.

Our PAC is the only federal PAC supporting our profession to advocate, organize, and push at the highest levels for the future of Internal Medicine.

Below is just a quick snapshot of our PAC in Action this year so far:

- ACP Services PAC supported ACP Services' annual Leadership Day in Washington, DC, which gathered **over 450 internal medicine physicians** from across the country to promote several initiatives with lawmakers on Capitol Hill.
- The PAC has seen a **22 percent increase** in medical students giving to the PAC by getting involved with a **simple contribution of \$10**.
- ACP Services PAC is increasing its visibility at ACP Services-sponsored events with its first-ever reception held at the Internal Medicine Meeting in Boston.
- ACP Services PAC has seen a **nine percent increase** in building our war chest to support lawmakers and candidates.
- ACP Services has **supported 64 races for the 2024 election** and legislative staff is hard at work meeting with members of Congress every week.
