As we start 2025, know that ACP Services PAC remains committed to advancing the interests of Internal Medicine (IM) and our patients. Despite the political hurdles in our way, we are steadfastly committed to building relationships with Congress in 2025 and advancing IM's advocacy goals at the national level. Below is a summary of what we accomplished in 2024:

- Successfully drove the inclusion of report language in Congress' appropriations bills for 2025, calling for a review of whether CMS has overestimated utilization of certain Medicare codes to prevent unnecessary cuts.
- Empowered members with a prior authorization toolkit and generated nearly 2,000 grassroots advocacy messages from ACP members urging Congress to pass the Improving Seniors' Timely Access to Care Act to reform the prior authorization process.
- Led the charge to shape prior authorization reform resulting in CMS Interoperability and Prior Authorization final rule requiring Medicare Advantage plans to make decisions within 72 hours for expedited requests.
- Protected physician payment by urging Congress to pass legislation to ensure annual inflation updates for IM physicians and protect patient access to care.
- Protected telehealth services by advocating for extended telehealth flexibilities, securing continued coverage for audio-only visits and delaying in-person requirements for behavioral health services.
- ✓ Defended scope of practice opposing legislation that would expand pharmacist scope of practice beyond safe level of training.

We know we have challenging work ahead of us. That's why the PAC needs your participation and engagement to keep our advocacy priorities in front of lawmakers. Even the task can feel daunting, we can't afford to sit on the sidelines this year.
